Our iconic five-day bike ride will mark the 80th Anniversary of the D-Day landings and remember the sacrifices made by brave servicemen and women. Starting Sainte-Mere-Eglise we'll cycle through Normandy, visiting the D-Day beaches, including Omaha, Gold and Juno. We'll also visit other key historical areas including Bayeux, Lisieux, Evreux and many more before ending in Paris. With around 400km over four days in the saddle this will be a cycle challenge to remember!

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Monday 24 June: Overnight ferry from Portsmouth to Cherbourg

Day 2: Tuesday 25 June: Cycling Sainte-Mere-Eglise to Bayeux

Day 3: Wednesday 26 June: Cycling Bayeux - Lisieux





Day 4: Thursday 27 June: Cycling Lisieux - Evreux

Day 5: Friday 28 June: Cycling Evreux - Paris

Day 6: Saturday 29 June: Coach via EuroTunnel from Paris to Portsmouth

Trip Safety

They are responsible for safety on the trip, and will make any changes to the itinerary they deem necessary, should local conditions dictate. Pre-trip administration - such as medical questionnaires and travel insurance as appropriate - is all done with your safety in mind.

We plan our trips around the optimal weather conditions, but could still be exposed to bad weather at any time. It is vital you are prepared for all conditions.
